Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly COVID-19 update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that there are no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility currently. As such, our total number of cases remains unchanged since our previous update.

We are glad to announce we are now open to window and lobby visits, and we will continue to keep you updated on our reopening plans as they are available to us by the State of Nevada. We encourage you to call the front desk to schedule window and lobby visits with your loved ones. Please observe the following facility guidelines put in place to help keep our facility COVID-19 free.

- **Visit times are as followed, Monday – Friday 9:30am – 4:00pm. For lobby visits, they are Monday-Friday 10:00am – 4:00pm. Saturdays and Sundays available by request.**
- **Visits can only be scheduled with the facility receptionist.**
- **All visitors must check in with the receptionist, sign in, and take temperature in the facility lobby before going to the window/ lobby due to tight guidelines. If at any time these visitor rules are not followed you may be asked to leave.**
- **All visitors must wear a mask.**
- **No more than 2 visitors per visit.**
- **Please ensure that when you call to make the appointment you notify the receptionist of who the two people visiting are. Please provide the name and relationship to the resident.**
- **If you have more than 2 people who wish to visit you need to make two separate visit appointments.**
- **All visits are 1 hour.**
- **Minors cannot participate in lobby visits.**
- **While visiting social distancing will be followed and you must remain distanced from your loved one.**
- **We will do what we can to ensure privacy, but staff will have to oversee visits to ensure core principles are followed.**
- **Please forward visitation guidelines to other loved ones, failure to follow the visitation rules may allow you not to visit. We must follow our core principles.**

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notifications of new cases. We will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
