



## **WEEKLY UPDATE**

**7/8/2021**

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We currently have a total of 0 residents and 2 staff members with COVID-19 at our facility. We are working very hard to prevent the spread of infection and following all of the recommendations of our federal and local health officials.

We are glad to announce we are open to window visits, and we will continue to keep you updated on our reopening plans as they are available to us by the State of Nevada. It is in the policy that you call the receptionist to schedule window visits with your loved ones. Please observe the following facility guidelines that are put in place to help keep our facility COVID-19 free.

- **Visit times are as followed, Monday – Friday 9:00am – 4:00pm. Saturday and Sunday visits are 10am-4pm.**
- **Visits can only be scheduled with the receptionist.**
- **All visitors must check in with the receptionist, sign in, and take temperature in the facility lobby before going to the window due to tight guidelines. If at any time the visitor rules are not followed you may be asked to leave.**
- **All visitors must wear a mask throughout the visit.**
- **No more than 2 visitors per visit, please call the receptionist to see if accommodations can be made.**
- **All visits cannot exceed 1 hour to allow for proper cleaning before the next visit.**
- **Visits are open to 16 and older only at this time due to vaccination availability.**
- **While visiting you must assure that social distancing will be followed and you must remain 6ft apart from your loved one.**
- **We will do what we can to ensure privacy, but staff will have to oversee visits to ensure core principles are followed.**
- **Please forward visitation guidelines to other loved ones, failure to follow the visitation rules may prevent you from visiting. We must follow our core principles.**
- **Any visitation requests called in over the weekend will need to be approved by the weekday receptionist. You will receive a call if the request cannot be fulfilled.**

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notifications of new cases. We will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
