Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 36 residents and 28 staff members test positive for the virus. In order to ensure the health and safety of everyone at College Park, we have continued to remain in compliance with mandated twice a week testing of all staff as well as weekly testing for residents. In doing so, we discovered two staff test positive, and were immediately sent home to quarantine. These staff members will continue to isolate until appropriate policies are undergone that will allow them to return to the facility. Additionally, we have had one resident test positive as well as exhibit symptoms of COVID-19. The resident was then immediately discharged to the hospital. As a result, we currently do not have any COVID-19 positive residents in house.

We realize the difficulties that come with being unable to see your loved ones, and we are continuing to closely monitor the situation in hopes that we can reopen for visitation soon. However, for the meantime, for the safety and well-being of our residents, please continue to reach out to your loved ones through phone, FaceTime, letters, and e-mail and feel free to contact us directly if you need assistance facilitating that communication. We are also currently allowing (closed) window visits for the friends and family of our resident as well. Family members and friends are able to call into the facility to let the staff know they would like a window visit, and the staff will help the resident see their loved one through the window.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
